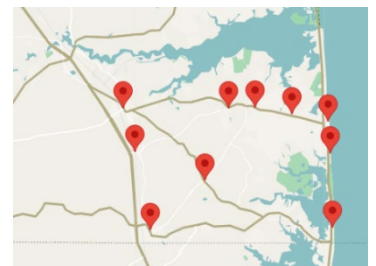
THE MISSION
